VOAD Coordinator, Phil Adams, called the meeting to order at 10:07 and asked Rev. Terry Hatfield of the Disciples of Christ (First Christian Church) of Independence, Kansas for a prayer over the deliberations.

John Collins, Coffeyville Ministerial Alliance president and member of the board for Long Term Recovery, presented a power point presentation over the proposed bylaws for the Long Term Recovery Committee. (RMC) Rebuild Montgomery County was the name the organization decided upon. After reviewing the proposed bylaws article by article, and making revisions agreed upon by the committee, a motion was made by John Collins to accept them as revised, there was a second and the committee voted unanimously to accept the bylaws as amended.
